Key Features of Programme

- **Driving Principles;**
- **Competency (Competencies)**
 is defined as ***“the behaviours that employees must have or acquire to achieve high levels”***
 E.g. Team working, communication skills, customer focus, problem solving, financial management, risk mitigation strategies, planning et al
- **Competence** is defined as ***“the system of minimum standards which must be demonstrated by performance & outputs”***
- E.g. A mechanism developed in conjunction with the organisation to ensure “integrated” performance is achieved throughout the organisation
